

How to Access Douglas County GIS Data on the Internet

- 1) Point your internet browser to <ftp://www.douglascountywa.net/>. (or click the link) No user name or password is necessary to access the site.
- 2) Double click the **Downloads** folder.
- 3) Our parcels and roads files are updated the most often. They are in zip files and are named DCParcels(date of last update), EWParcels(date of last update) and DCRoads(date of last update).
- 4) For the rest of our data, double click the **GIS Base** folder. Look through the folders for our other data.
- 5) If a file(s) is not in the **GIS Base** folder, please call (509) 884-7173 and ask to speak with Todd Wilson or Amanda Taub. If you have any questions, please call the above number.
- 6) You will need a GIS viewer to view our GIS data. There are many free viewers available for download on the internet. If you do not have a viewer, you can do an internet search for a "GIS viewer".
- 7) Our data is projected in NAD 83, Washington State Plane North.
