The Board of County Commissioners shall proceed to award the contract to the lowest responsible bidder, but may reject any or all bids if, in its opinion, good cause exists, or may waive informalities in the bidding when doing so is in the best interest of Douglas County.

PLANS, SPECIFICATIONS, AND BID PROPOSAL forms may be obtained from the Douglas County Transportation and Land Services office at 140 19th St. NW, Suite A, East Wenatchee, WA 98802, (509) 884-7173, upon receipt of seventy five (\$75.00) dollars. All bid proposals shall be accompanied by a bid proposal deposit in the form of cash, certified check, or surety bond in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the amount of such proposal. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into such contract and furnish satisfactory performance bond and certificate of insurance within the time stated in the specifications, the bid proposal deposit shall be forfeited to Douglas County.


