NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed bids will be received until 11:00 A.M., Tuesday, June 15, 2010, by the Douglas County Engineer and Chair of the Board at the Douglas County Public Service Building, 140 NW 19th St, Hearing Room, East Wenatchee, WA, 98802, for the construction of the "Eastmont Extension – Canyon B Bridge" Project, CRP 924. The bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at 11:00 A.M. Tuesday, June 15, 2010, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard.

The Contracting Agency will hold one (1) pre-bid meeting open to all plan holders. The meeting will be held on Wednesday, June 2, 2010, at 10:00 AM at the Douglas County Transportation and Land Services office, 140 19th St. NW, East Wenatchee, WA. Plan holders shall give notice of their intent to attend the pre-bid meeting to the Douglas County Engineer by phone at 509-884-7173 or by Fax at 509-888-0406. Attendance is not mandatory.

The Board of County Commissioners shall proceed to award the contract to the lowest responsible bidder, but may reject any or all bids if, in its opinion, good cause exists, or may waive informalities in the bidding when doing so is in the best interest of Douglas County.

PLANS, SPECIFICATIONS, AND BID PROPOSAL forms may be obtained from the Douglas County Transportation and Land Services office at 140 19th St. NW, Suite A, East Wenatchee, WA 98802, (509) 884-7173, upon receipt of seventy five (\$75.00) dollars. All bid proposals shall be accompanied by a bid proposal deposit in the form of cash, certified check, or surety bond in an

amount equal to five percent (5%) of the amount of such proposal. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into such contract and furnish satisfactory performance bond and certificate of insurance within the time stated in the specifications, the bid proposal deposit shall be forfeited to Douglas County.




