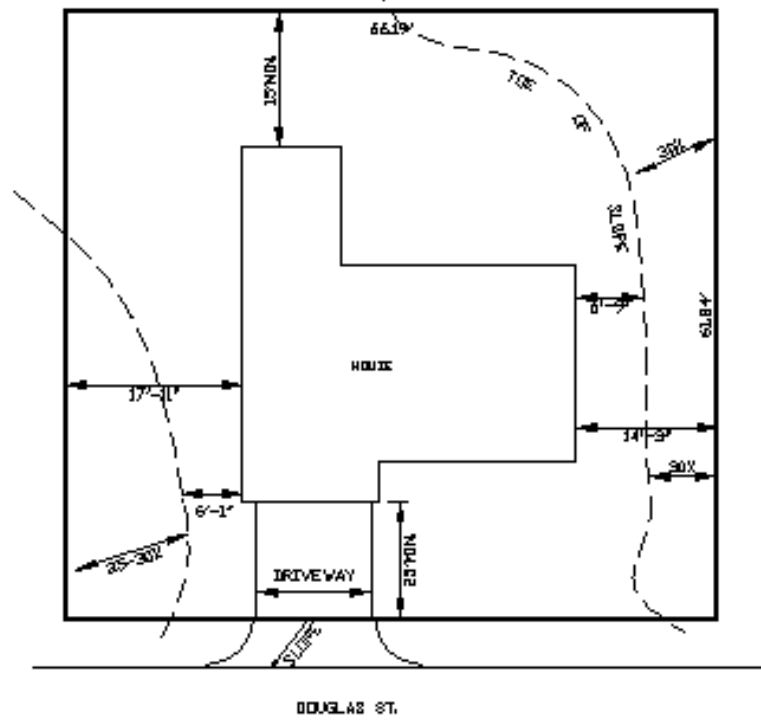


DRIVEWAY EXAMPLE

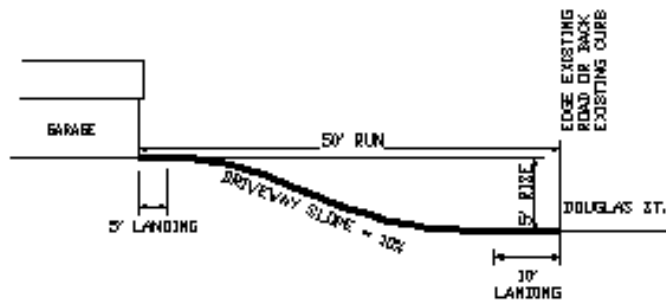
DRIVEWAY SITE PLAN

Slopes of land surfaces or roadbeds are generally expressed in percent of grade. A slope of 5 percent, for instance, rises vertically 5 feet over a horizontal distance of 100 feet.

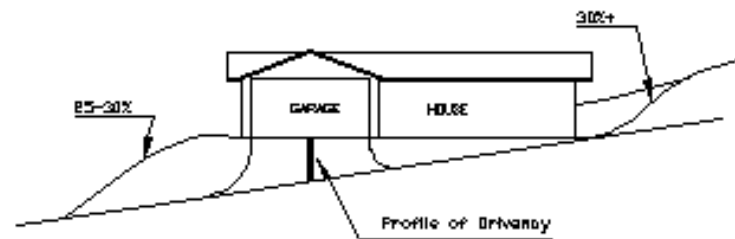
$$\frac{\text{Rise}}{\text{Run}} \times 100 = \text{Slope (expressed in percent)}$$

example: $\frac{5}{50} = .10 \times 100 = 10\%$

The MAXIMUM allowable slope for a driveway is 12%.
