Douglas County Veterans' Advisory Board (DCVAB) members shall be selected in accordance with RCW 73.08.035 and approved by the Douglas County Commissioner's.

RCW 73.08.035

Veterans' advisory boards.

(2) The county legislative authority must solicit representatives from either local branches of nationally recognized veterans' service organizations or the veterans' community at large, or both, to serve on the board. No fewer than a majority of the board members shall be members from nationally recognized veterans' service organizations and only veterans are eligible to serve as board members.

To fill a vacant board position the existing DCVAB members shall be responsible for soliciting names of veterans from local veterans' service organizations and the community as noted in RCW 73.08.035.

DCVAB members must be a resident of Douglas County.

The potential board member shall be evaluated and selected on the veteran's involvement in the community to promote and help veterans and their interests.

An evaluation form shall be used by the existing DCVAB members in evaluating the potential candidates.

After evaluation the nominees shall be voted on for a vacant position at a regularly scheduled DCVAB meeting or a special meeting per the DCVAB By-Laws.

The DCVAB may choose to go into executive session to discuss the candidates and recommend a candidate for selection.

The chosen candidate's name shall be submitted to the Douglas County Commissioners for approval.
