NOTICE OF VACANT POSITION ON THE DOUGLAS COUNTY VETERANS ADVISORY BOARD

RESPONSIBILITIES:

The Douglas County Veterans Advisory Board (DCVAB) shall advise and make recommendations to the Douglas County Board of County Commissioners (Commissioners) in needs of local indigent veterans, the resources available to indigent veterans, and programs that could benefit the needs of local indigent veterans and their families per RCW 73.08. The DCVAB shall advise the Commissioners on other Veterans programs and issues.

QUALIFICATIONS:

DCVAB members must be a veteran and must be a resident of Douglas County.

APPLICATION PROCESS:

A DCVAB member vacancy shall be filled by a recommendation from the DCVAB and approval by the Commissioners. To fill a vacant DCVAB position the existing DCVAB members shall be responsible for soliciting names of veterans from local veterans' service organizations and the community as noted in RCW 73.08.035.

Any potential board member shall be evaluated and selected on the veteran's involvement in the community to promote and help veterans and their interests. An evaluation form shall be used by the existing DCVAB members in evaluating potential candidates. After evaluation the nominees shall be voted on for a vacant position at a regularly scheduled DCVAB meeting or a special meeting per the DCVAB By-Laws. The DCVAB may choose to go into executive session to discuss the candidates and recommend a candidate for selection. The chosen candidate's name and DCVAB recommendation shall be submitted to the Douglas County Commissioners for approval.

TERM OF OFFICE:

DCVAB members shall serve for a period of three years or fill a vacant position for the remaining time of that position. A staggered schedule shall be maintained by the DCVAB.

MEETINGS:

Regular meetings of the DCVAB shall be open to the public, held on the 1st Friday of each month at the Veterans of Foreign Wars Post #3617, 211 11th Street NE, East Wenatchee Washington 98802 at 10:30 am. Should that day fall on a Holiday the meeting shall be held the following Monday at 10:30 am.
