Voter Registration and Election Information



Requirements

To register to vote in Washington, you must be:

- A citizen of the United States;
- A legal resident of Washington State;
- At least 18 years old by Election Day;
- Not under Department of Corrections supervision for a Washington felony conviction; and
- Not disqualified from voting due to a court order.

How to Register:

Online:

You can register or update your registration online at www.votewa.gov — you'll need a Washington State Driver License or ID. Make sure you register online by the October 26 deadline for the November 3 General Election.

By mail:

Call our office to request a Registration Form and mail it to our office by the October 26 deadline for the November 3 General Election.

In person:

You can register in person through November 3, Election Day at the Douglas County Courthouse in Waterville, WA.

Ballot Information:

On Tuesday, November 3, 2020 in Douglas County, there will be held a General Election conducted entirely by mail.

Replacement ballot:

Call Douglas County Elections to obtain a replacement ballot if your original ballot packet is lost, spoiled, or destroyed.

Keep Your Voter Registration Current:

Update your registration if you have moved or changed your name, or if your signature has changed. Simply update your information online or submit a new registration form by October 26 for the General Election or visit us in person through November 3, Election Day at the Douglas County Courthouse.
