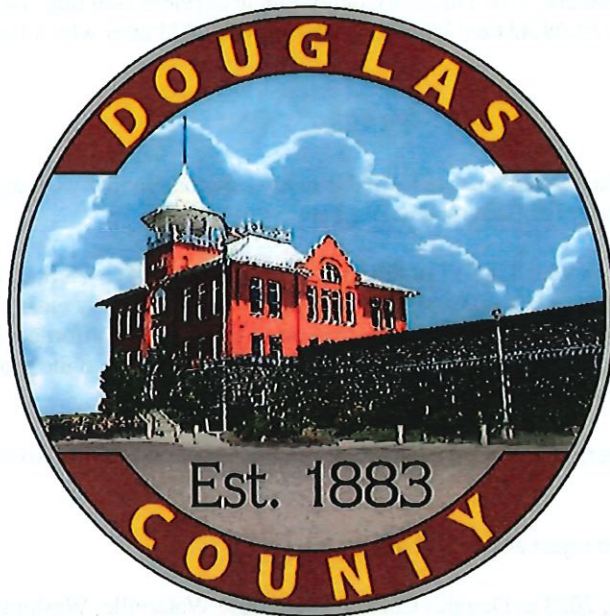

PART I – TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF BIDDING

A. Bid Opening

Sealed bids plainly marked “**Sealed Bid for Traffic Marking Paint & Beads, to be opened Monday, February 13th, 2023 at 10:00 AM**” will be received by the Douglas County Road Superintendent at the Douglas County Public Services Building located in East Wenatchee, WA 140 19th St NW, East Wenatchee, WA 98802, no later than the date and time specified for bid opening.

BIDS SUBMITTED BY FACSIMILE OR EMAIL TRANSMISSION WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

This contract provides for furnishing and delivering **Traffic Marking Paint & Beads** in accordance with the plans and specifications.

B. Bid Contents

The sealed bid must contain all pages of the bid documents:

- Part I Terms and Conditions of Bidding
- Part II Terms and Conditions of Purchase
- Part III Specifications (Bidders not fully meeting specifications must identify and list exceptions. All exceptions are subject to review, inspection, testing and approval by Douglas County.)
- Part IV Proposal and Signature

C. Clarification of Bid

A bidder may submit information to clarify the bid previously received by the Douglas County Road Superintendent. The information must be received in writing or by facsimile transmission prior to the date and time set for bid opening. The sole purpose of this provision is to allow clarification of any perceived ambiguity in Part III Specifications of the bid, or to modify responses to specifications in the bid. **NO OTHER CHANGES ARE ALLOWED EXCEPT BY SUBMITTING AN AMENDED SEALED BID PRIOR TO THE DATE AND TIME SET FOR BID OPENING.** Any unsealed clarification information received by the Douglas County Road Superintendent that discloses price will not be considered by the Board of County Commissioners and shall result in rejection of the entire bid.

D. Bid Review and Evaluation

Douglas County shall be evaluating bids against published Washington State cooperative purchasing prices.

The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Washington reserve the right to reject any or all bids, waive informalities, and to contract as the best interests of Douglas County may require. When evaluating bids, the following criteria, in addition to price, specifications, delivery terms, quality of goods, and guaranteed efficiencies, will be considered:

1. Past performance record of the bidder with contracting agencies;
2. The bidder's experience, technical qualifications and skill;
3. The guaranteed availability of materials included in the bid;
4. The bidder's ability and capacity to fully perform within the time required, taking into account the bidder's existing performance commitments and past performance;

E. Estimated Quantities

Douglas County has, in good faith, estimated the material quantities expected to be used during 2023. These quantities are estimates only and are not a guarantee of or limit upon Douglas County's expected purchases.

Low VOC White Standard
Waterborne Traffic Marking Paint 8,500 gallons

Glass Beads for Pavement Marking

F. Delivery Terms

Materials shall be delivered to Douglas County's shop located at 800 N Monroe St, Waterville, WA 98858. Deliveries shall be made on an **as needed basis** within fourteen (14) calendar days after ordered by Douglas County, unless otherwise agreed upon in writing. Delivery time is a material performance term.

Terms of delivery are F.O.B. Douglas County's Waterville shop and delivery costs are included in the price of materials delivered.

G. Alternative Vendors

The successful vendor is not bidding on a requirements contract. Douglas County reserves the right to purchase from other vendors if a specified delivery time cannot be met, if vendor-supplied products are deemed to be materially defective or if a more favorable price for delivered materials, after considering costs of delivery, may be obtained from another supplier.

PART III – SPECIFICATIONS

The following materials shall meet or exceed all WSDOT 2023 Standard Specifications for Road, Bridge, and Municipal Construction, Section 9-34 "Pavement Marking Material":

1. Low VOC Yellow Standard Waterborne Traffic Paint
2. Low VOC White Standard Waterborne Traffic Paint
3. Glass Beads for Pavement Marking Materials

The vendor shall provide, upon request, evidence that delivered materials comply with all specifications.

Failure to return this Declaration as part of the bid proposal package will make the bid nonresponsive and ineligible for award.

NON-COLLUSION DECLARATION

I, by signing the proposal, hereby declare, under penalty of perjury under the laws of the United States that the following statements are true and correct:

1. That the undersigned person(s), firm, association or corporation has (have) not, either directly or indirectly, entered into any agreement, participated in any collusion, or otherwise taken any action in restraint of free competitive bidding in connection with the project for which this proposal is submitted.
2. That by signing the signature page of this proposal, I am deemed to have signed and have agreed to the provisions of this declaration.
